
# Saint Pope John XXIII (1881-1963)

### Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli -- Saint Pope John XXIII

November 25, 1881 – Born , 4<sup>th</sup> of 23 children

Autumn 1893 – Enter seminary, age 12

August 10,1904 -- Ordained

March 19, 1925 - consecrated a Bishop

1925-1953 – Serves as Diplomat to Bulgaria, Turkey, Greece, and France

January 12, 1953, made a Cardinal

October 28, 1958 – Elected Pope after 11 votes, Papacy begins

October 11, 1962– Opens Second Vatican Council

June 3, 1963 – Dies

September 3, 2000 – Beatification


April 27, 2014– Canonization






